## GENERAL OVERVIEW

### Objectives:

- Utilize the nursing process in describing the physiology, risk factors, prevention and management of quality of life issues experienced by those with cancer.
- Describe the physiology, risk factors, prevention and management of potential alterations in gastrointestinal, urinary, cardiopulmonary, and protective mechanisms in those with cancer.
- Discuss the scientific basis for the practice of oncology nursing.
- Apply health promotion principles to recognize, prevent and detect potential malignancies.
- Describe the physiology, risk factors, prevention and management of potential oncologic emergencies.
- Discuss professional issues involved in the performance of oncology nursing practices.
