### **What is the PSB- Health Occupations Aptitude Examination?**

The PSB-Health Occupations Aptitude Examination is a reliable predictor of your potential success in the program. The PSB exam is specifically designed for healthcare programs. It is composed of five parts that will be evaluated by multiple choice questions administered in a three hour computer based session. The test measures an applicant's ability, skill, knowledge, and attitude for performance in the health care environment. Areas of emphasis include academic aptitude (vocabulary & arithmetic), spelling, reading comprehension, natural sciences, and a vocational adjustment index. It is used to determine an applicant's readiness for entry into the program.

### **Who must take the PSB Exam?**

All candidates applying for admission to the program are required to take the PSB exam.

### **How does an applicant register to take the PSB Exam?**

Once a completed application is received from an applicant, he/she will be scheduled for a date to come to the hospital to sit for the examination. An examination Fee of \$75.00 (cash, check or credit card) must be paid by each applicant. If the applicant is unable to keep this assigned test date it will be the applicant's responsibility to reschedule the exam by speaking directly with the program director. Failure to do so shall result in the forfeiture of your testing fee.
