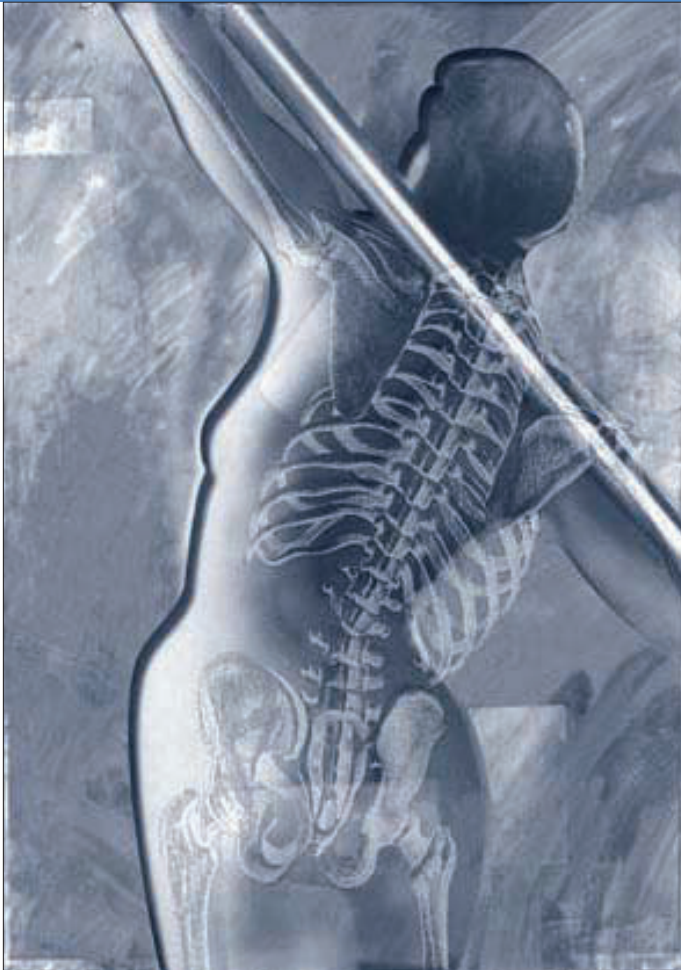

- Examine special considerations in pediatric orthopaedics
